Our Krewe Mascot is Odin...

Board of Directors: Consists of 4 members (President, Vice President, Captain/Treasurer, & Secretary) Board meetings are generally open to all members... agenda's will be sent out prior to each meeting to ensure transparency and encourage input... meetings will be closed when sensitive issues are to be discussed...

Committee Board Members: Will consist of 7 members (Ball, Float/Parade, Community Outreach & Involvement, Social Gatherings, Raffle, Bingo, & Golf Tournament.

Court: For the new folks, Court is our Krewe's royalty for the year... court is responsible for creating his/ her own collar (at his/her own expense) based on that year's theme... It is such an honor to represent your Krewe amongst all the Krewe of Southwest Louisiana... you should expect 2 months prior to the ball to begin working on your collar and yes, many Krewe members will help you ...

Krewe Mardi Gras Ball is a night of entertainment and partying...The theme and court will be discussed and voted upon at the first meeting of the new year....Invite your friends and remember this is a method of promoting our Krewe & recruiting new members for the future... the attire will rotate each year, with formal being a yearly option for anyone, cocktail, and themed/costume... Table assignment will start first for Court, Board Members, and general membership.

Mardi Gras Events

12th Night is held at the Civic Center on January $6^{th} \sim it$ is a night held to honor the previous years royalty... the Krewe will have a table set up for us to support our outgoing King & Queen...

Children's Parade ... All member's kids welcome - just make sure they have a Krewe shirt... held the Sunday before "Fat Tuesday" we generally need to be locked ~ loaded ~ lined up by 2pm for this parade...

Royal Gala... held on the Monday evening before "Fat Tuesday" at the Civic Center... the Krewe will have a table set up for us to cheer on our Court.

Krewe of Krewe's Parade... held on "Fat Tuesday" Only members are allowed to ride for this parade... we generally needed to be locked ~ loaded ~ lined up by 4pm... Members must wear their Krewe Parade shirt... Don't forget your mask ~ as MGSW asks that all float riders wear a mask for the beginning of the parade (until we pass the cameras).
